Abstract Submission Deadline: December 20, 2012

Content review is required for all presentations. To that end, faculty are required to submit a one-page abstract on their assigned topic to finalize their participation. Please email your abstract to abstracts@iconmeeting.org by the December 20 deadline.

As you prepare your presentation you are reminded that you have attested that:

- Your presentation will promote quality or improvements in healthcare rather than the propriety business interests of any commercial organization.
- All scientific research referred to, reported or used in support or justification of a patient care recommendation will conform to the generally accepted standards of experimental design, data collection, and analysis.

Objectives

It may help you to know that our audience is comprised of physicians (Cardiothoracic and vascular surgeons, interventional radiologists and cardiologists, vascular medicine specialists, etc.), nurses, technicians, and researchers from around the world who desire to update their knowledge on cardiac and endovascular topics from 'head-to-toe' (including acute stroke, carotid artery disease, structural heart disease, heart failure therapies, thoracic and abdominal aortic pathologies, and peripheral vascular disorders). At the conclusion of iCON2012, participants should be able to:
Assess the newest technology and interventional techniques and determine the appropriate application to patients with complex coronary and vascular disease
Review progress on evolving techniques in the treatment of patients with carotid and peripheral arterial disease
Apply the results of clinical trials and evidence-based medicine in the management of patients with cardiovascular disease
Integrate into practice the knowledge obtained through real-time case demonstrations.

Presentation Timing

All presenters will be allowed **8 minutes** for their presentations. In order to keep the program on time, we must ask for your cooperation in adhering to your 8-minute limit.

Registration

As a courtesy we will waive your iCON2012 registration fee.

Airfare

Arizona Heart Foundation (AHF) will reimburse your non-refundable coach airfare (maximum of \$1,600).

Hotel Expenses

AHF will reimburse the cost of your accommodations (earliest arrival on Sunday, February 12 and latest departure on Thursday, February 16). You will be required to reserve and pay the 'up front' cost of your hotel accommodations.

Reimbursement will be provided based on the days you participate as faculty at iCON2012 (the night before and of your scheduled faculty assignment). We hope this permits you to attend the entire conference. Please note, ACCME guidelines prohibit AHF from reimbursing you for iCON2012 conference days on which you do not participate as faculty.
